Use commas to separate three or more words or phrases in a series Examples: The colors of the flag are red, white, and blue I scraped, sanded, and varnished the old chair They had money, peace of ...

Chapter Three Quoting, Paraphrasing, and Avoiding Plagiarism

A “quote” is a direct restatement of the exact words from the original source The general rule of thumb is any time you use three or more words as they appeared in the original source, you should treat it as a quote A “paraphrase” is a restatement of the information or point of the original source in your own words

Which Words Do I Teach and How?

Tier three words are far more common in informational passages than in literature They are specific to a domain or field of study (lava, fuel injection, legislature, circumference, aorta) and key to understanding a new concept within the text Because of their specificity, tier three words ...
